This well spudded on August 9, 1958. 8-5/8" casing was run and set at 318', cemented with 225 sacks cement. The 8-5/8" casing was tested for 30 minutes, holding 800psi., a successful shut-off was obtained. This well is scheduled for a San Andres test for an approximate depth of 4500'. *Cement 1 sack added 15 min*
