Attached please find NBOCC Form C-102 wherein it states that Tennessee Gas Transmission Company plans to re-enter and plug back the abandoned well located in the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 25, T-16-S, R-33-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was originally drilled as the State 1-25 by the Frontier Drilling and Production Company of Midland, Texas. The well was drilled to a total depth of 5190 feet and plugged and abandoned April 13, 1956. It is planned to re-enter this well and attempt to establish production from the Queen sand at an approximate depth of 4000 feet. The procedure for this workover is outlined on the attached form. This well will be re-named the Tennessee Gas Transmission Company State A. A. Kennitz "B" No. 2.

The No. 1 well has not been spudded on this lease yet, but application has been made for permission to drill. The No. 1 well is to be located 660 feet from the north and east lines of the same section and is projected as a 11,500 foot Pennsylvania Wildcat.
