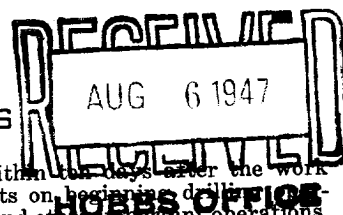

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well circulated with 10 tons mud laden fluid. Bottom of hole cemented with 25 sack cement. Well mudded to 3,400' at which point 25 sack cement plug was set. 7" casing parted at 3400' and pulled. Hole filled with mud to bottom of 10-3/4 Casing and cement plug set. No effort made to pull 10" as it was cemented by circulating to surface. 10" casing filled with mud with cement plug in top of casing and cellar. Regulation 4" marker was set up.
