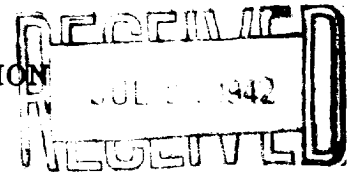

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Will fill hole with 11# mud from 4615' to 4550'. Will bridge with 2 sacks Cal-seal. Then, will let set 4 hours, then run plug of 20 sacks of cement. Will fill hole with 11# mud to 1500'. Will bridge with two sacks of Cal-seal, let set 4 hours, will run plug of 20 sacks cement. Will then fill hole to bottom of cellar with 11# mud. Will dump 10 sacks cement in cellar and erect 4" regulation marker, to extend 4' above the ground. Work to be done by Halliburton.
