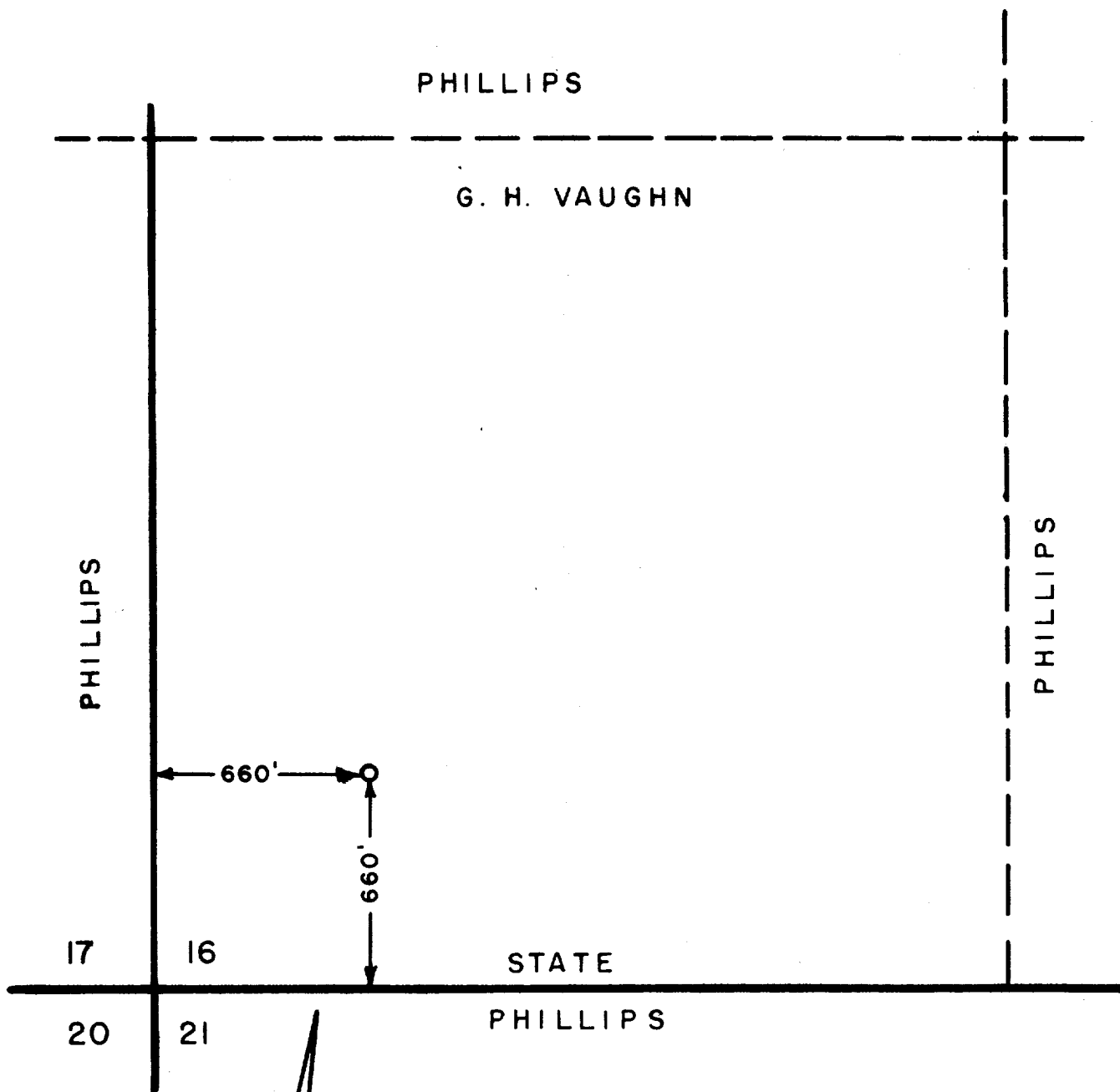

Dear Mr. Maddox:

Thank you for your letter of March 9th. We have received notice of approval of your bond and your Notice of Intention to Drill is now in order for approval. This approved form will be mailed to you today.

Enclosed please find the necessary forms for drilling and producing wells in New Mexico. The Forms C-111, C-112, C-113 and C-114 are connected with transporting and storing of oil therefore it will not be necessary for you to file these reports. The Form C-115 and Form C-116 are the only reports necessary after the completion of the well.

I am also enclosing a few copies of our Circular No. 6-A. This is an abstract of Rules and Regulations of the Commission. At the present time we do not have available a complete set of these rules but as soon as we receive a supply I will forward a copy to you.


