
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Run 23 joints, 1014.95', 10 3/4" OD 45.5# J-55 casing and 78 joints, 22.41.21', 40.5# H-40 casing; total of 3256.16'. Casing set 3270.64', cemented with 345 sacks common cement, plug 3228'. Tested O.K. before and after drilling plug.


