THE BUREAU OF CONSTITUTIONAL COMMISSION

Section 10 of the Act

ARTICLE OF ASSOCIATION TO BE FILED

1. The purpose of this Association is to promote the study and dissemination of information regarding the Constitution of the United States and the principles of federalism, and to encourage the participation of citizens in the political process.

2. The Association shall be organized and operated as a non-profit organization, and its assets shall be used solely for the purposes of the Association.

3. The Association shall have the right to solicit and receive contributions from individuals and organizations.

4. The Association shall have the right to publish and distribute materials, and to engage in other activities that are consistent with its purposes.

5. The Association shall have the right to enter into contracts and to incur liabilities in the furtherance of its purposes.

6. The Association shall have the right to sue and be sued, and to defend itself in any legal action.

7. The Association shall have the right to acquire, hold, and dispose of real and personal property.

8. The Association shall have the right to borrow money and to pledge its assets as security for any loan.

9. The Association shall have the right to accept and hold gifts and bequests.

10. The Association shall have the right to make and receive loans to and from its members.

11. The Association shall have the right to make and receive loans to and from other organizations.

12. The Association shall have the right to make and receive loans to and from the government.

13. The Association shall have the right to make and receive loans to and from any other source.

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
