DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was loaded with heavy mud and the pipe shot at 3000 and off at 2800'. Recovered 2826'11" of 5½" casing. A cement plug was placed from 3980-4080 opposite the 5½" casing seat at 4030 to protect the base of the salt. Another plug was placed from 1100-1200 opposite the 8 5/8" casing seat to protect the top of the salt. An additional plug was placed in the top of the 8 5/8" casing. The hole was loaded with heavy mud at all times.
