DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4330 Lime. Dumped gravel 4330-4325; dumped 120 quarts SNG 4325-4270; dumped gravel 4270-4260; Calseal 4260-4200. Loaded hole with oil. Used Double Action A. G. 24 hour time bomb. Shot detonated 1:00 PM Oct. 25th. Checked top of Calseal found 4250; dumped gravel 4250-4215. Dumped 180 quarts SNG 4215-4150 with Double Action A. G. 24 hour time bomb. Dumped gravel 4150-4140; Calseal to 4079, shot detonated 10:10 A. M. Oct. 28th. Cleaned out to bottom and after recovering oil load, swabbed 3/4 bbls oil, 1/2 bbls water in six hours. Preparing to acidize.
