DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4325' - January 20, 1944 with tubing set at 4318', perforated from 4304'-8' and Hookwall packer set at 3960', introduced 500 gallons Dowell XX Acid at maximum pressure of 2000 pounds, using sufficient oil to flush tubing and displace acid. Had only small show oil before acid, treatment provided no change in oil or gas. Operations shut down to prepare for glycerin shot.
