Plan to perforate from 4140 feet to 4140 feet; from 4253 feet to 4257 feet;
from 4261 to 4266 feet; from 4270 to 4288 feet with one jet per foot.

The new zones perforated will be selectively treated down 3 inch tubing with
1000 gallons acid, 15,000 gallons water and 15,000 pounds sand.

A Baker packer will be run on 2 inch tubing and set above all perforations.

The well will then be used for a water injection well.
