**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Set bridging plug at 4485'. Dumped 40' of Calseal on plug and filled hole back to 4445'. Drove 8' of lead wool on top of Calseal plug and filled hole back to 4437', with same. Dumped 8' of Hydromite on top of lead wool which gave plugged back depth of 4429'. Ran casing swab and bailer June 16, and 17th and found bottom water not completely shut off. Loaded hole with oil then dumped 5' of Hydromite and brought plugged back depth to 4424'. Released drilling rig at midnight June 21, 1952. Moved rig off location and installed pumping unit to test well for water shut off. At date of this report pumping tests have not been conclusive enough to determine if water has been shut off completely.
