8-5/8" 29# Lapweld casing was cemented at depth of 1410' with 450 sacks of 6% jel cement. Plug was pumped down to point 77' above shoe at 9:00 A.M. January 16, 1952. Cement circulated back into cellar.

We propose to move Rotary tools off; move Cable Tools in and, after 48 hours, bail hole dry to test casing, if casing tests OK we will drill plug then bail hole dry again, if necessary, and test cement.
