Form C-103 reporting in detail the amount of casing, kind, where set, amount of cement and the manner of testing for shut-off, results of such test and any other pertinent information.

Form C-105, Well Record, and Form C-103 outlining in detail the method of the plugging operation.

Further the 4' dry hole marker does not have the quarter quarter section inscribed as required.

Failure to comply with the above by July 15, 1957 will subject all operations of your company to cancellation of allowances.
