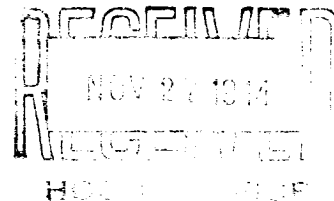

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3 5/8" casing was run and cemented with 50 sacks of cement on November 23, 1944. The total depth of the hole was 1791' and the casing shoe is at 1788'. Rotary-tools were moved out and cable-tools were rigged up. The hole was bailed dry and the plug was drilled on November 23. On November 24 the hole was dry and drilling ahead was begun. On the evening of November 24, we were drilling at 1825' in anhydrite.
