### FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was completed August 26, 1955, for an initial production of 894 barrels of oil per day. Production has declined rapidly as well as the bottom hole pressure. Remedial work in the deeper producing zones has been considered and it was decided that such work would be uneconomical. The well is now shut in. It is proposed to plug back this well as follows: plug-off the perforated interval from 10,594' to 10,711' with 35 sacks of cement (10,551-10,831'); pull 5½" casing from approximately 7000' and cement with 25 sacks of cement, half in the 5½" casing and half out; cement with 50 sacks of cement spotted at 4570' to 4695'. The well will then be shut-in and consideration given to the possibilities of recompletion in the Grayburg. (Verbal permission received from Warren H. Mankin)
