7" O.D. casing was set at 11,270' and cemented with 350 sacks cement. Top of cement @ 9,500' by Temp. Survey. Casing perforations 11,140' - 11,150' were squeezed with 75 sacks cement. Casing now perforated 11,000' - 11,014' and 11,026' - 11,034' with 4 HFF.
