Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

We plan to commence work on _____, 19_____.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Dry Hole

The present condition of the well is as follows:

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:
Fill with heavy mud laden fluid to 3525 and there put in one 4 ft wooden plug and ten sacks of cement @ 3525'. Fill with mud to 1985 and put in one four ft wooden plug and ten sacks of cement @ 1985' Fill with mud to 1385 and put in one 4 ft wooden plug and 10 sacks of cement @ 1385. Fill with mud to 805' and put in one 5 ft wooden plug and 10 sacks of cement @ 805'. Fill with mud to 240' and put in one 5 ft wooden plug and 10 sacks of cement and then fill with mud to top of hole.
