Acidized with 10,000 gallons of chemical process 15% LSTNE acid as follows: Initial & maximum pressure 2100# @ 6 BPM, Minimum pressure 1100 # @ 6.8 BPM. Final pressure 1900# @ 6.6 BPM. Average pressure 1750#. Average rate 6.6 BPM. Overflushed w/25 BO. After 2 minutes SITP-Vacuum. In 15 hours swabbed 152 BF (62BAW / 52 BLO & 90 BHO). SFL 4000' FS, EFL 7000' FS. on a 2 1/2 hour test follow acid job well flowed 212 BF (5% BS & W) on 2 1/2/4 choke.
