DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On 11-22-55 went in hole and conditioned mud. Spotted 75 sacks cement plug from 13812'-14009'. Pulled up to 11006'. Conditioned mud. Spotted 75 sack cement plug 10809'-11006'. Pulled out of hole. Conditioned hole for 4 hours. Tagged top of second cement plug at 10820'. Laid down drill pipe. Ran 348 jts of 5 1/2" casing with Halliburton guide shoe and float collar. Total casing 10687.71' set at 10705.15'. Cemented with 400 sacks of Trinity Inferno cement with 4% gel and 150 sacks of Trinity Inferno neat cement. Ran Worth Well Service temperature survey and found top of cement at 8662'. WOC for 24 hours and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. Pressure held OK.
