DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17 1/2" hole to 369 feet on 7-20-55. Ran 11 joints 346.32' of 13-3/8" 48# H-40 casing set at 368.72' and cemented with 250 sacks of Lone Star Portland cement with 3% gel and 200 sacks of Lone Star Portland neat cement. Plug down at 1:48 PM 7-20-55. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 1800# for 30 minutes OK on 7-21-55. Started drilling cement plug at 5:30 PM 7-21-55 and drilled to 374'. Pressured up to 600# on formation. Formation broke down. Pumped in formation 4 barrels per minute @ 300#.
