The rig was shut down for repairs on October 10, 11, 12, 13, 14,
15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27, 1955. On
October 28, 1955 the well was drilled from a depth of 60 feet in
Sand to a depth of 85 feet in Sand, where water was encountered.
Rig again broke down on October 29, 1955 and was down for repairs
on October 29, 30, 31 and November 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, 1955.
