You are the operator of several wells in the Townsend Wolfcamp Pool which are presently shut in and are apparently uneconomical to produce. These wells are the State "D" Nos. 2, 4, 6, 7, and State "C" No. 3, all located in Section 1, T-16-S, R-35-E.

Since it would appear that you will probably not produce these wells, it would be proper for you to consider plugging and abandoning the wells at this time. Therefore, unless you have an immediate need for these wells, I would suggest that you consider plugging and abandoning.

Would you please advise this office as to your plans for this group of wells.
