Dear Mr. Ramey:

In reply to your letter of June 5, 1972 I would advise your office of the following future intentions for the wells mentioned in your letter:

State D-2, will be plugged back to 10,250 in the future.

State D-4, 6, and D-7, can be ultimately produced in the Townsend Wolfcamp zone or possibly drilled deeper to the Morrow gas pay found to the west, or plugged back to the Upper Wolfcamp zone.

State C-3, same reason as above, since the gas spacing is 320 acres to the west.

As you can see, there are valid reasons for having these wells being temporarily abandoned.

I assure you that if no future producing possibilities were involved, they would be plugged and the salvage sold.
