The above well was checked on Nov. 25, 1957 at 4:30 P.M.

There is no indication that any one has been at the well to final plug and abandon.

The  $\frac{1}{2}$  barrel that is placed in the hole is washed about  $3\frac{1}{2}$  feet below the surface, with the drilling line celled ever and around the top of the opening. The hole is about 30 to 35 inches in diameter where the rains have eroded the hole to a greater diameter than it was originally.
