Enclosed please find a copy of Mr. Engbrecht's letter of November 27, 1957 setting forth the conditions on the Alvon Drilling and Exploration Co., Inc. Dearduff No. 1-E Sec. 3, T-16-S, R-35-E as he observed them on November the 25th.

Your letter of October 23, 1957 addressed to Mr. Sheardy A. Lamb directed that the well be properly plugged and abandoned by the 23rd of November; however, as stated by Mr. Engbrecht, this work has not been performed.

Since no response has been received from this company, it is my recommendation that a show cause hearing be held.

Dear Mr. Montgomery:

The above well was checked on Nov. 25, 1937 at 4:30 P.M.

There is no indication that any one has been at the well to final plug and abandon.

The $\frac{1}{2}$ barrel that is placed in the hole is washed about 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet below the surface, with the drilling line coiled over and around the top of the opening. The hole is about 30 to 35 inches in diameter where the rains have eroded the hole to a greater diameter than it was originally.
