DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 24, 1953 an attempt was made to stimulate production of well by acid-frac treatment of 5000 gal of gel acid and 10,000 lbs. of sand. On swab tests after treatment only recovery was water with a show of oil. On 9-14-53 well was shut-in preparatory to moving in pulling unit to clean out well. On 9-22-53 moved in pulling unit to clean out, and on 23rd well kicked off and flowed 70 bbls of oil and died. On 9-26-53 swabbed 15 hours and recovered 60 bbls of fluid, 70% water and 30% oil. On 9-27-53 swabbed 24 hours and recovered 125 bbls of fluid, 50% water and 50% oil. On 9-28-53 swabbed 24 hours and recovered 137 bbls of fluid, 50% water and 50% oil. Now installing pumping unit to pump well and put on production.
