Perforated 7", 29#, N-80, R-3, Csg. w/8 shots per foot (4 jets & 4 bullets) from 10,320-21 and 10,352-53, and tested for water shut-off with Halliburton hook-wall pkr. on 2 1/2" tubing. 300' water blanket. 5/8" bottom hole choke. Pkr set at 10,300 with tail to 10,320. Halliburton test tool open for 60 min. Steady weak blow air increasing to medium blow air thruout test. Rec. WB & 90' gas cut mud. No water.
