T.D. 11,562'. The 9-5/8" casing at 4560 is cemented to surface.  
 From 11,562-11,353 is 75 sack cement plug. (Canyon porosity).  
 From 11,353-10,430 is mud-laden fluid.  
 From 10,430-10,232 is 75 sack cement plug (Welfcamp porosity).  
 From 10,232 to surface is mud-laden fluid.  
 At the surface is a 10 sack cement in 9-5/8" casing, a 9-5/8" to 4" sledge  
 with a 4" pipe sticking 4' above the ground and a 4" valve on the 4" pipe.
