DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At total depth 4603 feet in dolomite, ran 189 joints (4985 feet) of 8-5/8" OD, 13-lb., J-55, SS and NI, new casing and cemented at 4597 feet with 2200 sacks (1000 cement mixed with 1000 sacks B-J Dixie plus 25 bentonite, followed by 200 sacks neat cement). Plug down 9:40 PM, August 12, 1954. Had 36 hours. Tested casing with 1800 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 7-7/8 inch hole ahead.
