DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17-1/2 inch hole to 320 feet in Red Beds. Ran 9 joints (299.43') 13-3/8 inch OD, 48-lb., E-40, Seamless, SB&G new National casing. Cemented casing at 314 feet with 325 sacks (175 neat cement plus 150 sacks E-J Plastic-A). Stopped plug at 290 feet. Used Tams Pattern shoe. Plug down 12:05 AM, July 30, 1954. WOB 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 11-inch hole ahead.
