Drilled to total depth 10,522 feet. Ran 324 joints (10,400 feet) of 15.5 lb and 17 lb. SS, new casing and cemented at 10,410 feet with 500 sack slow-set cement. Plug down 3:45 PM, February 9. After 48 hours WOC tested casing with 1500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Test O.K.
