## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17½ inch hole to 330 feet in red beds. Ran 10 joints (305 feet) 13 3/8" O. D., 48 lb., H-40, SS, new casing with Texas pattern shoe and cemented at 319 feet with 200 sax 4% bentonite and 100 sax neat. Plug down 3:25 PM, December 2, 1952. Cement circulated to surface. WOC 27 hours. Then tested 13 3/8" casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Test O.K.
