DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At total depth 4620 feet in San Andres Dolomite, ran 148 joints (4604 feet) 8 5/8 inch OD, 32-lb, #55, SS, 8 in. ID, J&C, new and second hand casing. Cemented at 4615 feet with 2400 sacks (1100 sacks Halliburton Pozmix + 1100 Sacks cement + 200 bentonite followed by 200 sacks neat cement). Plug down 7:25 PM, November 30. Circulated out estimated 200 sacks cement. 100 36 hours. Tested casing with 1000 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and commenced drilling 7 7/8 inch hole.
