DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17½" hole to 325 feet. Ran 10 joints (309') of 13 3/8 inch OD, 48 lb., H-40, SS, New casing with Texas Pattern shoe. Cemented with 350 sacks (175 sacks regular cement plus 175 sacks Halliburton Pozmix "A" plus 25 bentonite). Cement circulated. Plug down 11:15 AM, November 16. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes. Test O K. Drilled plug and drilled 11 inch hole ahead.
