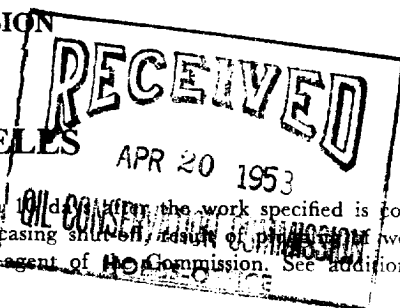

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 252 joints of 5-1/2" casing, 10,486.87', set at 10,501', first stage with 150 sacks with 10% gel. Job completed 9:15 A. M. 4-11-53.

Opened Baker 2-stage tool, circulated hole 8 hours. Recemented with 900 sacks regular with 10% gel and 100 sacks regular neat cement. Job complete 7:05 P. M. 4-11-53. Rotated casing on first stage.

Tested 5-1/2" casing with 1000# for 30 minutes at 1:05 A. M. 4-13-53. No drop in pressure. Drilled cement and Baker 2-stage collar at 9590. Tested casing and 2-stage collar with 1400# for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilled float collar and cement to 10,497'.
