DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Placed cement plugs as follows: 50 sacks at 4638 feet; 25 sacks at 1905 feet; and 25 sacks at 329 feet. Skidded rig due west 50 feet to drill Schenck Well No. 1-A. Inasmuch as a part of the rig now stands over the cellar of Schenck No. 1, placement of the surface plug and regulation monument will be deferred until Schenck No. 1-A is completed and the rig is removed from the location. When the surface plug and monument are placed in Schenck No. 1, a follow-up C-103 will filed.
