DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 17 1/2" hole to 329'. Run 10 joints (329') of 13-3/8" OD, 48#, H-40, S.S. New Casing with Texas Pattern Shoe. Cemented with 350 sacks (175 sacks regular cement plus 175 sacks Halliburton Pozmix "A" plus-2% Bentonite). Cement was circulated. Plug down July 1, 1954. W.O.C. 24 hours. Tested casing with 1000# P.S.I. for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug and drilled 11" hole ahead.
