Spudded 17 3/8" hole 4-10-56.

On April 11, 1956 we ran 350' of 13 3/8" casing set at 360' and cemented with 440 sacks neat circulated to surface. After WOC for 30 hours, tested casing with 950 psi for 40 minutes before and after drilling plug. No drop in pressure. Resumed drilling operations.
