This well was drilled to total depth of 12,630 feet by the Western Natural Gas Co. and was plugged and abandoned by them. The lease on which the well was drilled expired by term and we have acquired the lease. We plan to go back into the well and attempt a completion in the Queens sand. The procedure will be as follows: Go into well and clean out to a point below the Queens, then go in and log and perforate the Queens. After this is done we will wash the section with 200 gal. of mud acid, then treat it with 5000 gal. and test. All of the work will be done inside of the casing that is already in the hole and the cement plug in the bottom of the casing which was put there when Western Natural drilled the well will not be drilled out as it is below the Queens Sand. A one well bond is included with this notice.
