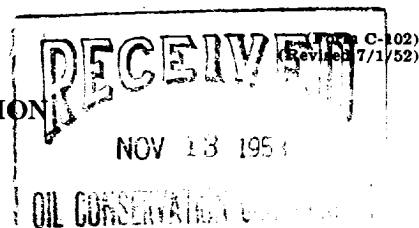

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

On August 17, 1953 we filed notice with you of our intention to drill the above described well to a depth of approximately 10,800 feet. The well has been drilled to that depth without encountering commercial production of oil or gas. A surface string of 13-3/8" casing was cemented at 357 feet, and an intermediate string of 8-5/8" Casing was cemented at a depth of 4674 feet.

We now propose to continue drilling and to drill the well to a depth sufficient to test the Devonian formation, which it is believed will be encountered at an approximate depth of 14,000 feet, unless commercial production of oil or gas is encountered at a lesser depth.

The drilling will be done with rotary tools by Western Service Drilling Company, Inc. of Longview, Texas.

If commercial production is found a production string of 5-1/2" OD Casing will be set and cemented with 500 sacks.
