Gentlemen:

On April 12, 1955, we filed our Notice of Intention to Drill, Form C-101, on our Daughtry Company at all Well No. 1, North Lovington Wildcat, 1830 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from the East line, Section 32, T-15-S, R-36-E, Lea County, with your Hobbs office. Rule No. 104 (b) states that a wildcat shall be located on a tract of not less than 40 surface contiguous acres and shall be located within 100 feet of the center of the 40 acre subdivision. You will note from the attached plat that our location was located only 1830 feet from the East line of Section 32 which makes it a 150 feet out of the center of the NE/4 of the NE/4 of the section. We would like to request an exception to Rule No. 104 (b) and it is our understanding that you can grant this exception without notice and hearing since the necessity for the unorthodox location was based on topographical conditions, that is, it was relocated due to an existing highway as illustrated on the attached plat. The ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 660 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases under the proposed location.

This No. 100-100000-100000, which shall be located on a tract of not less than 10 surface acres, shall be located within 100 feet of the center of the 10 acre and 100 feet from the East line of Section 31 which runs to a lot out of the center of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the section. We wish to request an exception to Rule No. 104 (2) and it is our understanding that you can grant this exception without notice and hearing upon the necessity for the proposed location was based on geological conditions, that is, it was located due to an existing highway as illustrated on the attached plat. The ownership of all oil and gas leases within a radius of 100 feet of the proposed location is common with the ownership of the oil and gas leases within the proposed location.
