Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 4920' in lime. Ran 134.8 jts. (4911') of 8 5/8" OD 32# SR J-55 SS Casing set at 4919.04' and cemented with 2250 sacks 4% gel and 562 1/2 cubic feet strata crete with 300 sacks of neat cement on bottom. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 2:30 A.M., February 12, 1956. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off. Prior to drilling plug, 2000 pounds pressure was applied with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute interval. After drilling plug, 1000 pounds pressure was applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.
