Cement plug set on bottom - 5 sks col Seal and 35 sks cement & mudded to salt.
Wood plug and Cement set just below salt bed - 5 sks col Seal & 20 sks cement
Cement plug in casing at top of salt. & filled with mud.
Wooden plug set at 250' to shut off water sand.
Plug to surface with 5 sks col Seal, 1 yd of gravel and 25 sks cement.

10 tons of mud used.
PULLED 712' 8" of 8 5/8" Casing
