DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "AH" #1 was drilled to a total depth of 8760' in line. 13 3/8" OD 48# H-40 SS Csg. was set at 339' and left in hole, cement circulated. 8 5/8" OD 24# & 32# Csg. was set at 3369' and left in hole, cement circulated. The hole was loaded with approximately 543 barrels of 10.4 mud laden fluid. Four plugs of cement were spotted: 50 sacks (160') 8600'-8760'; 50 sacks (160') 8240'-8400'; 100 sacks (325') 6075'-6400'; 50 sacks (160') 3218'-3378' in bottom of 8 5/8" Csg; 3 sacks (10') 0-10' in top of 8 5/8" Csg. A 4" pipe marker has been installed to mark the abandoned location. The pits have been filled and leveled, location has been cleared of junk.
