

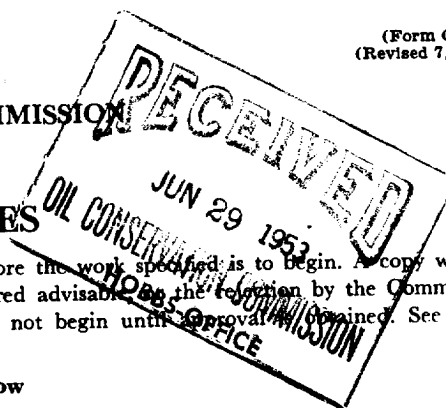

 (40-acre Subdivision)
Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

State "AH" No. 1 was drilled to a total depth of 8760' in lime. Nine drill stem tests were taken and logs were run by Schlumberger. No evidence of commercial production was indicated on any of these tests.

It is proposed to load the hole with mud laden fluid, spot 50 sacks (160') 8600 to 8760'; 50 sacks (160') 8240 to 8400'; 100 sacks (325') 6075-6400'; 50 sacks (160') 3218 to 3378' in bottom of 8 5/8" casing; 3 sacks (10') 0-10' in top of 8 5/8" casing. A 4" pipe marker is to mark the abandoned location.

This report is to correct the total depth of this well as reported on C-102, April 14, 1953 from 11,765' to 8,760'.
