**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

State "AH" No. 1 was drilled to a total depth of 3370' in lime. Ran 96 1/3 jts. 3355.19' of 8 5/8" OD 24# & 32# 8R thd J-55 SS Casing set at 3369' and cemented with 1500 sacks of which 1100 contained 4% gel and 70 sax stratacrete and 400 sacks regular neat on bottom. Circulated out approximately 30 sacks. Plug down 4:13 A.M. February 2, 1953. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure. Test was satisfactory and drilling was resumed.
