DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 8430' in lime. The 5 1/2" casing was originally perforated from 8418' to 8426' and tested. The casing was re-perforated from 8412' to 8387' and from 8379' to 8373', tubing re-run with packer, mud displaced with water, water displaced with oil and well was swabbed in. The well was swabbed to the pits for three hours and flowed to tank for 30 minutes to clean up. Flowed 14 hours on 36/64" choke and produced 355.4 bbls. oil cut .2%. The GOR was 510, FTP 110#, FCP 0# (packer), gravity 40.8°.
