State "AE" #4 was drilled to a total depth of 6204' in lime. Ran 6068.30' (197 1/2 jts) of 5 1/2" OD 14# and 15.5# J-55 Csg set at 6080' and cemented with 400 sacks neat. Plug down 10:10 P.M. 1-14-54. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours; 1000# pressure was applied, with all valves closed, for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure, test was satisfactory.
