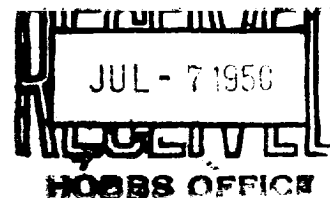

As production from this well has rapidly declined and results of acid treatment on other wells in the immediate area proved favorable, it is proposed to treat the above well with approximately 1000 gallons 15% acid in an attempt to increase oil production and to retard the present rapid decline. Jelly seal will be spotted at the bottom of the hole and section 4515 to 5094 acidized.
